
## RHICONICH ESTATE

## Principal Lochs (O.S Map 9 Cape Wrath)

1. Gharbet Beag: Grid Ref: NC 265507 Salmon, Sea Trout and Brown Trout



Best wind: North West or South East (A good wind is important)

Recommended flies:

Stoats Tail double Elver Hairy Mary double

Small size 10 or 12

Small Tubes Silver Doctor Muddler

Waddingtons Connemara Black Black Pennel

Soldier Palmer

(If all else fails large Collie Dog fished fast!)

Main Lies:

Worth a try in spate conditions if fish are running • Pool

Best in high water, first place fish rest, good lie by sunken stone • Tail of Loch

Good Sea Trout lie as well, fish lie close in to the bank

 Ministers Main lie in low water, best fished from boat

Black Point

Best in high water, on its day the best spot on the loch Narrows

Fish both streams. In high water fish redds pool in burn Burn Mouth

Fish drop back here from narrows. Quite deep. • Green Point

## n.b NEVER TAKE BOAT THROUGH THE NARROWS

Salmon run June to Sept. Salmon: Average size 6 – 8lbs.

Main Run: Early July.

Best fishing in strong wind, after a spate with water over flat stone at boat house. In addition there are two or three pools in the Rhiconich River that are worth fishing. Sea Trout: Plenty of Finnoch, (please return) but very few fish over the 1lb mark (same problem all over Scotland)\*

Brown Trout: Good size 8 -12oz.
